

LUT Install Instructions

1. Import Your Clips to Your Project

2. Open the Effects Browser

Once you have your clips ready, navigate to the right side of your screen and click the two overlaid boxes icon to show the Effects Browser.

3. Add the 'Custom LUT' Effect to Your Clip

After you open the Effects Browser, click 'Color' in the left tab and look for the Custom LUT effect on the right side once there.

Click and select 'Custom LUT' and drag it over to apply on your clip.

4. Choose a Custom LUT to Apply to Your Clip

Now for the next part, you need to make sure the **Inspector** is showing. You can show/hide the inspector by clicking the button in the top right of the screenshot below with the three lines and sliders on it.

Once you have that showing, you'll see the Custom LUT effect applied to your clip. Click the drop-down bar next to LUT and select 'Choose Custom LUT...'

This will open up your files allowing you to find the LUTs from 'FCPX Full Access'.

5. Find the .cube file and click 'Open' to apply the LUT to your clip.

6. Adjust the Intensity of the LUT

You can adjust the intensity of the LUT once you've applied it to your clip by adjusting the 'Mix' slider. LUTs affect all clips differently and so should be used as a STARTING position to finish your colour grade. Use FCPX's colour grading tools or our '**Ultimate Colour Control**' plug in to fine tune your grade!
